WHEN WILL THE WORLD END?

The _____ of _____.

Fact: “This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven” (Acts 1:11).

Manner: “They will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky, with power and great glory” (Matthew 24:30).

Time: “No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father” (Mark 13:32).

Who: “There will be a resurrection of both the righteous and the wicked” (Acts 24:15).

How: “Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed – in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed” (1 Corinthians 15: 51-52).

The _____ of _____.

The Judge: “When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, He will sit on His throne in heavenly glory. All the nations will be gathered before Him” (Matthew 25: 31-32).

The Standard: “If you, O Lord, kept a record of sins, O Lord, who could stand?” (Psalm 130:3).

“... That very word, which I spoke, will condemn him at the last day” (John 12:48).

The Sentence: “Then the King will say to those on His right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world.’ Then He will say to those on His left, ‘Depart from Me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels’ ” (Matthew 25: 34,41).
