WELCOME TO THE TRADITIONAL SERVICE OF DARKNESS!

To impress on the minds and hearts of believers the awful consequences of sin and magnitude of the Savior's sacrifice, the ancient church held a special service, called Tenebrae, in the last days of Holy Week. The word means darkness.

The Tenebrae ceremony is carried out by extinguishing the candles in the "Tenebrae hearse," or sevenfold candle stand, one by one. As the entire church is gradually cast into darkness, the death of Jesus on the cross is symbolized, and we are reminded of the greatness of God's love which led Him to give His Son to die on the cross.

The noise of the closing of the Book near the close of the service symbolizes the closing of Jesus' tomb. The sound is to acknowledge that the meaning of the cross is fulfilled. The penalty of sin has been paid.

One candle remains burning throughout the service. This central candle is called the Christ candle and it symbolizes our Savior. Its removal symbolizes the death of Jesus, and its return signifies His resurrection. Even in the midst of death and darkness the forces of hell did not prevail against the light of Christ. His resurrection is sure! He lives eternally! And we, too, shall live! Let us, then, confidently await dawn of Easter and proclaim its joyful message; Jesus Has Risen From The Dead!

THE NAIL OF BETRAYAL

THE SCRIPTURE READING

While He was still speaking, Judas, one of the Twelve, arrived. With Him was a large crowd armed with swords and clubs, sent from the chief priests and the elders of the people. Now the betrayer had arranged a signal with them: "The one I kiss is the man; arrest Him." Going at once to Jesus, Judas said, "Greetings, Rabbi!" and kissed Him. Jesus replied, "Friend, do what you came for." Then the men stepped forward, seized Jesus and arrested Him. With that, one of Jesus' companions reached for his sword, drew it out and struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his ear. "Put your sword back in its place," Jesus said to him, "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword. Do you think I cannot call on

my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels? But how then would the Scriptures be fulfilled that say it must happen in this way?" At that time Jesus said to the crowd, "Am I leading a rebellion, that you have come out with swords and clubs to capture Me? Every day I sat in the temple courts teaching, and you did not arrest Me. But this has all taken place that the writings of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples deserted Him and fled.

THE NAIL OF INDECISION

THE SCRIPTURE READING

But the chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowd to ask for Barabbas and to have Jesus executed. "Which of the two do you want me to release to you?" asked the governor. "Barabbas," they answered. "What shall I do, then, with Jesus who is called Christ?" Pilate asked. They all answered, "Crucify him!" "Why? What crime has he committed?" asked Pilate. But they shouted all the louder, "Crucify him!" When Pilate saw that he was getting nowhere, but that instead an uproar was starting, he took water and washed his hands in front of the crowd. "I am innocent of this man's blood," he said. "It is your responsibility!" All the people answered, "Let His blood be on us and on our children!" Then he released Barabbas to them. But he had Jesus flogged, and handed Him over to be crucified.
