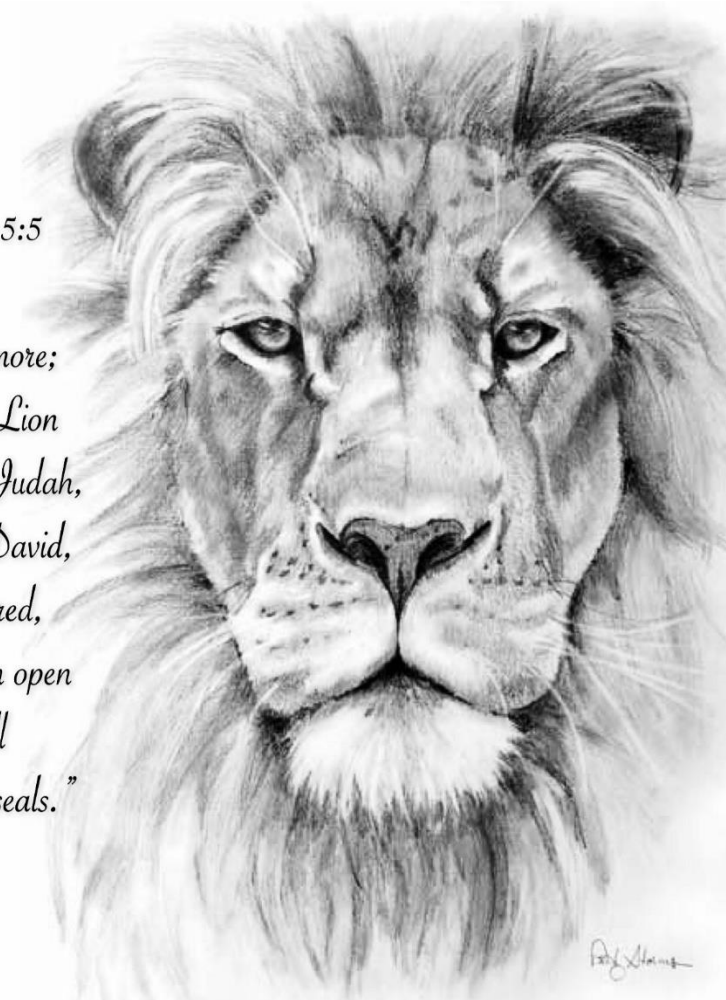
Sunday, July 24th @ 10AM
