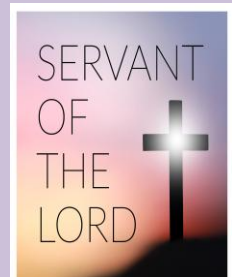
service. Wednesday night worship services start at 7PM. A Fellowship Supper is offered before each service, 5:46 – 6:45PM, for a free-will offering.
